End User Report

What is End User Report and what is it for?

- It is the account declaration system for AWS
- It is the tool that helps recognize accounts, their respective segment, geographical location, and subsequent application to other discounts for consumption development

What changed?




Before, it was mandatory to declare the account; the validity or accuracy of the information did not invalidate the recognition of the account and its discounts

Now, it is mandatory to declare the end customer information associated with the account, which must be strictly accurate. Inconsistencies or errors invalidate the recognition of the account and therefore the application of the discount,

The term "public sector" is not limited solely to government entities, but encompasses a variety of clients that offer **community services**, such as both public and private educational institutions, cooperatives, compensation funds, among others.

13. Government customer *

Government Customers are defined as any agency, organization or other entity that is within or substantially owned, funded, managed or controlled by:

a) The executive, legislative or judicial branches of government within the US, its territories, or of any other country's government at any level;
b) A quasi-governmental entity (e.g., the World Bank or a government-owned corporation)
c) An international governing/regulatory body (e.g., an EU institution)
d) Publicly funded institution (e.g., a college, university or hospital) OR
e) Higher tier prime contractor, consultant or entity working in support of the foregoing
